ERIK KIERNAN '92



Erik Kiernan was initiated in 1992 and graduated in 1996 from The University of Arizona with a BA in communications. Brother Kiernan was the House Manager for Gamma-Rho for many years and also served as Grand Master of Ceremonies, Grand Treasurer, and Pledge Educator. After graduating, he served two years as a Co-Alumni Advisor for the chapter. He met his future wife at a Kappa Sigma party and is forever grateful for that.

Brother Kiernan got his start in fundraising when he worked for Fraternity Management Group after college. He moved to Boston in 2000 and began working for CCS fundraising soonafter. He is now a Senior Vice President and is a team leader in the firm's Boston Office. CCS is a global fundraising consulting and management firm.

He has worked on and designed multi-million dollar campaigns for dozens of nonprofits. He has helped secure nearly \$1 billion for inspirational causes in New England ranging from environmental protection to inner-city youth education. His responsibilities include designing capital campaigns and managing a team of campaign directors.

"I consider myself very fortunate to have spent almost my entire undergrad time at Gamma-Rho while we were at El Capitan Court. Everything about the old house was conducive to the brotherhood experience, from the smallness of the Chapter Room and welcoming atmosphere of the 12 apartments to the small parties and the fact there was always someone around to hang out with. I got to know everyone in the house and they got to know me. Mike started his career as an attorney for the US Securities and Exchange Commission. After leaving the SEC, he practiced corporate law at two large international law firms. Mike is currently the Chief Legal Officer of Avnet, Inc., which is a global technology distributor and

solutions provider with approximately \$25 billion in annual revenue. While with Avnet, he lived in Brussels for three years serving as the lead lawyer for its international businesses. He serves on the board for the Arizona Chamber of Commerce and has served as a director for other nonprofits. He is currently serving on the Kappa Sigma Educational Foundation. He and his wife Laura have three kids, Alex, Morgan, and Ryan.

David Gosselin was initiated in 2001 and studied accounting at The University of Arizona. Mr. Gosselin was the Grand Treasurer and the Grand Master of Kappa Sigma during his undergrad, and believes that Kappa Sigma shaped his future and helped him in his personal development.

David is a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) and partner at DDBMcKennon is a full-service CPA firm that specializes in equity crowdfunding and public company audits. Mr. Gosselin is also a partner for BizCFO, Inc., an accounting consulting firm, and an instructor for the CapCPA Education Foundation. He is devoted to being an involved board member and sits on the board for Breast Cancer Angles and is an Associate Director at Wescom Credit Union. He has participated in various

speaking engagements related to Jobs Act and Equity Crowdfunding and was a recipient of the 2017 40 under 40 award from CPA Practice Advisor.

"When I look back at my time at Gamma-Rho, I believe the biggest benefit I received was what it did for my personal development. There was no one lesson, no one moment, or one year during college that changed my view or perspective, but a multitude of various challenges that created discomfort, and in that discomfort came personal growth. As a natural introvert, and generally coddled teenager, the world becomes limiting due to the inability to generate and create your own destiny."

"I truly believe things like Rush Week helped me be a better speaker and networker. Handling a Chapter Room of 100+ brothers who don't agree on many things, provided an opportunity for negotiation and navigating contentious situations, which taught me to be a better leader and business owner. Initiating pledges allowed me to see the power and emotion of inclusion and togetherness. But to say I learned any of these things on my own would be misleading. In all these situations, there were brothers who I looked up to that networked so naturally, who led effortlessly, commanded fiercely, spoke passionately, argued tirelessly, or advocated relentlessly. Learning from books can give me a piece of paper upon graduation, but learning from those brothers who were better than I at so many aspects of life, provided the example and path I needed to succeed."
