Policies

The entire list of Kappa Sigma, UA and House Corporation policies is posted on our website in resources behind a password. Ask the advisors or officers for the password if you do not have it. A few basic rules to understand:

- We, like any other fraternity or sorority, must follow the policies of the University of Arizona, and Federal and State laws. Additionally, Kappa Sigma has a code of conduct and our Gamma Rho House Corporation has rules relating to the use of the Chapter House.
- At no time can there be alcohol present at a pledge/new member activity.
- At no time can there be alcohol on Chapter House property that has a content above 15%.
- Any event that is approved for alcohol on Chapter House property must have licensed 3rd party security and servers. Approval of any event with alcohol will depend on the track record of the chapter. This is not likely to exceed a few events per semester.
- All events off campus that include alcohol must occur at 3rd party licensed establishments.
- The ratio of guests to members shall be: 1 to 1 for any events with alcohol and not more than 2 to 1 for non-alcoholic social events.
